Project Update

The Regional District of Nanaimo's Greater Nanaimo Pollution Control Centre Secondary Treatment Upgrade Project is proceeding on schedule. Phase I of blasting was successful and concluded on October 5th. Final blasting activities will take place in early 2018. The majority of the excavation work is complete and ground improvements required to stabilize the soil in the event of an earthquake are nearing completion. Over the next year, crews will build new concrete structures including the secondary treatment bioreactors and clarifiers.

Site Lighting:

Site lighting is required to maintain safety. The lighting will be shut off overnight.

Concrete:

Many large and small concrete pours are scheduled through to the end of 2018. Some large concrete pours will require that concrete trucks, pumps, and finishing equipment continue working after the main construction activities have ended for the day and beyond the standard construction noise bylaw hours.
