Dear Minister Hansen and Minister Hawkins:

At its June 2002 meeting, the North West Regional Hospital District Board discussed its role under the reorganized health care system, and its relationship with the Ministries of Health and the Northern Health Authority.

By resolution, the Board decided it remains interested in participating in capital planning and cost sharing for health care facilities if the following key issues are resolved to the satisfaction of the Board.

- 1. meaningful participation in the proposed regional hospital district review,
- a commitment from you to communication and consultation with regional hospital districts on issues that affect regional hospital districts, and
- agreements with your Ministries and the Northern Health Authority on policy and procedures for capital planning and project implementation.

A few examples of the key issues follow.

- As many regional hospital districts have stated in previous correspondence, the lack of regional hospital district representation on health authority boards creates an accountability void.
- There has been minimal communication from your ministries with regional hospital districts regarding capital planning and project status, yet there appears to be an expectation of continued regional hospital district cost sharing.

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- The regional hospital district role and cost sharing formulae review was proposed as early as 2000, but has not proceeded. This coupled with the lack of communication makes it very difficult for regional hospital districts to undertake long term planning, and even annual financial plans (budgets).
- Regional Hospital Districts have not heard if there is an expectation that regional hospital districts will partner with the private sector for projects proceeding under a Public/Private Partnership.

Your prompt attention in responding to these key issues would be appreciated. Thank VOU.
