RE: **Three Lots (20, 21 and 22) – Former Errington Elementary School Site on Grafton Avenue**

The Board of Education of School District 69 recently passed a motion to return two lots of Crown Land (23 and 24) at this site back to the Provincial Government as required by the School Act. Additionally, the Board has made application for a Crown Land Grant for property adjoining the current Errington Elementary School site for the purposes of improving traffic flow and parking at the school.

At the Public Board Meeting held on May 26, the Board asked staff to give public notice of its consideration of options for the remaining three lots on Grafton Avenue at the former Errington Elementary site. The following advertisement has been placed in the local paper soliciting feedback on options including possible sale of the lots to fund the traffic improvements on the anticipated Crown Land Grant adjoining the current Errington Elementary site:

Specifically, these are Lots 20, 21 and 22, Block 46, District Lot 139, Nanoose District, Plan 1989. One outcome could be the sale of the three lots to provide the funding for a turnaround and parking lot at Errington Elementary School.</p> <p>Prior to making any final decision with respect to the disposition of this property, the Board invites written comments from the public on or before June 30, 2015.</p>
