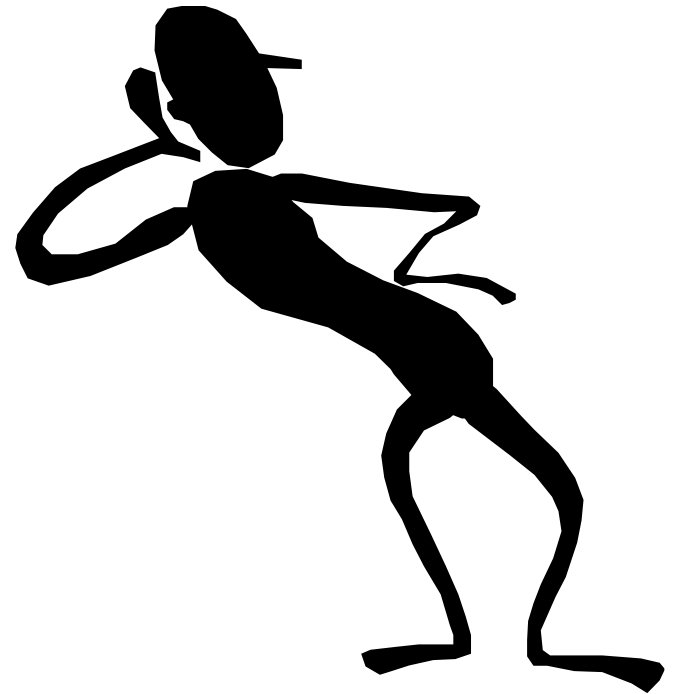

SWMP Vision

Current SWMP Plan

In 2002 the RDN adopted “zero” as their waste diversion target, meaning that the RDN will continuously strive to reduce the amount of waste requiring disposal.

- Existing plan has three main components:
 1. A Zero Waste Plan.
 2. The Residual Waste Management Plan.
 3. A Waste Stream Management Licensing Bylaw & Illegal dumping program.
